

Starting the Exam

You will need to wait in the Boulevard until your surname is called. Please keep talking to a minimum in order to hear your name.

While waiting to go through to the bag drop area, take time to get out your exam equipment and to use the toilet. The bag drop is for putting down belongings and walking straight through to the hall. There should be no talking in this area. Coats should already have been removed and equipment to hand.

Toilet Breaks

Once you have entered the exam room, toilet breaks will only be authorised for those with toilet passes. Please note that there will be no toilet breaks permitted within the first or last 20 minutes of the exam.

Stationery

You will need to be prepared with your stationery before entering the bag drop area. You will be unable to leave the exam room once inside.

We may be able to give you stationery on loan for the duration of your exam if we have spares available.

Malpractice

We are under obligation to report any cases of suspected malpractice to the JCQ. This ranges from non-verbal communication (such as laughing or making facial expressions) to unauthorised items found within the room. The full list can be found on the JCQ website. Any form of malpractice could result in disqualification.

Equipment Required

- A clear pencil case (Black pens x2, pencils, ruler, highlighter, eraser, clear pencil sharpener, compass, protractor)
- A Calculator when specified (Ensure the lid of the calculator is left in your bag)
- Your school ID card
- You may bring in a clear bottle of water with all labels removed if you wish.
