On our development plan for 2024/25 is our commitment to continue to improve parental engagement at Malbank. Through the academic year, there are frequent opportunities for parents to engage with teaching and pastoral staff, from coffee mornings to traditional parents' evenings.

We may not have all the answers on the night, but the idea is that it opens up a channel of discussion that may not otherwise have taken place. We are happy to offer advice and guidance on the challenges of getting your young person to revise and work at home or any other topic you would like to hear about, but ultimately, it will be an open forum to come and ask questions, make suggestions or just put some names to faces.
